THE CLERMONT COMMUNITY FUND OF GCF

For nearly 50 years, The Greater Cincinnati Foundation (GCF) has been helping people achieve their charitable goals, supporting nonprofit organizations, and creating lasting good work in the region.




In 1993, GCF teamed with local leaders through the Clermont 20/20 initiative to establish The Clermont Community Fund of The Greater Cincinnati Foundation. This permanent endowment brought together diverse donors with a common goal of enhancing the quality of life in this community.

Through the contributions of local residents, the leadership of the Fund's Advisory Board and the resources of GCF, grants totaling nearly \$7,000,000 have been awarded to organizations and programs serving Clermont County.

Since its inception, The Clermont Community Fund has been making a positive impact in the area, helping create a healthy and vital community by enhancing the quality of life for all.

The Fund's affiliation with GCF provides extensive grantmaking experience and philanthropic stewardship skills. In addition, grant dollars from The Clermont Community Fund are combined with financial resources from GCF's grant pool to make an even greater impact in Clermont County.

Grants that make a difference

The Clermont Community Fund supports nonprofit organizations that make a difference in the community by enhancing the quality of life for all. Recent grant recipients include:

-  **Clermont Senior Services**, providing in-home and community based services such as adult day care, caregiver support, and transportation, which enable older adults to live independently;
-  **Clermont Counseling Center**, advocating for and providing housing alternatives to the mentally ill in safe, affordable housing that meets the individual's needs;
-  **Child Focus, Inc.**, serving more than 5,000 children and their families through early learning, mental health, school, and foster care services.
