About Our Grant Programs

GCF's grant programs are designed to make a profound difference in our community. As an exemplary steward of the community's charitable resources since 1963, GCF awards grants to qualified 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations in eight counties: Butler, Clermont, Hamilton and Warren (Ohio); Kentucky: Boone, Kenton and Campbell (Kentucky); and Dearborn (Indiana).



Arts & Culture

Cincinnati Public Radio (CPR)

\$34,700 grant toward the purchase of a new ENCO Digital Audio Delivery (DAD) system.

Cincinnati Symphony Orchestra (CSO)

\$50,000 grant toward purchase of ticketing and patron tracking technology, ticket scanners and wireless infrastructure needed to support the new components at both Music Hall and Riverbend.

Playhouse in the Park

\$44,815 grant toward the update of HVAC system.

Community & Economic Development

The AMOS Project

\$60,000 grant toward the salary of a second staff member to assist The AMOS Project in building a stronger fundraising base of support.

BLOC Ministries (BLOC)

\$52,000 grant toward the purchase of building materials and supplies to rehab three abandoned homes of Hispanic families in Lower Price Hill.

Cincinnati Center City Development (3CDC)

\$100,000 grant toward revitalization, upgrade and expansion of Washington Park from six acres to eight acres.

Cincinnati USA Regional Chamber – Agenda 360

\$70,000 grant to support the ongoing work of Agenda 360 through 2011.

Working In Neighborhoods (WIN)

\$50,000 grant toward development and management of the Borden Corridor Revitalization Project with a goal of restoring the South Cumminsville community back to its historic homeownership rate of 54%.

Education

Notre Dame Urban Education Center (NDUEC)

\$20,000 grant toward the purchase of materials and equipment for the NDUEC after school program in Covington, KY.

Visions Community Services (VCS)

\$50,000 grant toward the salary and benefits of a new, full-time Director of Nurturing Families Program.

Environment

Greater Cincinnati Energy Alliance (GCEA)

\$90,000 grant over two years to hire an administrative assistant/office manager

Health

Caring Partners International, Inc. (CPI)

\$45,000 grant toward the addition of three staff members to expand the organization's capacity to meet the increasing need for the distribution of donated medical equipment and supplies.

Center for Respite Care, Inc. (CRC)

\$35,000 grant toward the establishment of 20 additional apartments for homeless individuals leaving the CRC following medical respite follow-up and hospital discharge.

Cincinnati Association for the Blind and Visually Impaired (CABVI)

\$50,000 grant toward salary and benefits, training and needed supplies for a new outreach social worker.

SARA – IRP

\$31,000 grant toward the purchase and launch of the Cincinnati CHAT web site program to inform, educate and energize area youth with regard to the epidemic of HIV/AIDS/ STD and is modeled after a program web site in Columbus, Ohio.

Winton Hills Medical & Health Center (WinMed)

\$50,000 grant toward the purchase and installation of an Electronic Medical Record (EMR) system.

Human Services

Cincinnati-Hamilton County Continuum of Care (CoC)

\$150,000 grant to provide the technical support and additional capacity needed to transition the CoC from a coordinating agency to a HUD designated Unified Funding Agency.

Easter Seals Work Resource Center (WRC)

\$50,000 grant toward the expansion of the Production Social Enterprise Program to help facilitate transitional employment opportunities for its disabled and disadvantaged special needs worker population.

Elementz

\$80,000 grant over two years to hire a full-time, "Circle of Support" caseworker who will serve as the primary contact and support for youth ages 18-24.

Family Services doing business as Lifepoint

\$25,000 grant to build capacity in the Parents with Pride program by increasing the scope of responsibilities and working hours of six group facilitators.

Our Daily Bread (ODB)

\$30,000 grant toward the addition of a new, part-time volunteer and special projects coordinator position.

Starfire Council of Greater Cincinnati

\$40,000 grant towards the replacement of the roof.

United Way of Greater Cincinnati (UWGC)

\$100,000 grant toward the renovation of UWGC's headquarters and construction of a new conference center adjacent to their current facility.
