About Our Grant Programs

GCF's grant programs are designed to make a profound difference in our community. As an exemplary steward of the community's charitable resources since 1963, GCF awards grants to qualified 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations in eight counties: Butler, Clermont, Hamilton and Warren (Ohio); Kentucky: Boone, Kenton and Campbell (Kentucky); and Dearborn (Indiana).



Arts & Culture

Ensemble Theatre of Cincinnati (ETC)

\$50,000 grant for an upgraded, in-house ticketing system, related licensing fees and installation, and replacement computer equipment.

The Mercantile Library (ML)

\$40,000 grant toward renovation of the Reading Room and Modernization Campaign, entitled *Fund 175*.

Community & Economic Development

Keep Cincinnati Beautiful (KCB)

\$25,000 grant toward expansion of the Future Blooms project to beautify vacant buildings and lots.

Mill Creek Restoration Project

\$50,000 grant toward construction of Phase 2 of the 3 Phase Greenway Trail project.

Over-The-Rhine Housing Network (OTRCH)

\$50,000 grant toward rehabbing and connecting five formerly abandoned buildings in OTR into a single structure containing 25 units of permanently supportive housing for chronically homeless alcoholics.

People Working Cooperatively (PWC)

\$60,000 grant toward critical home repairs for 250 low-income homeowners.

Education

Boys & Girls Clubs of Clermont County (BGCCC)

\$100,000 grant to support the start-up of a new teen center in New Richmond, Ohio.

Northern Kentucky Community Action Commission (NKCAC)

\$75,000 grant to support the start-up of a new Boone County Head Start Center to serve low-income and disabled 3 and 4 year olds.

Civic Garden Center

\$50,000 grant toward signage development for The Green Learning Station.

Health

Faith Community Pharmacy (St. Vincent DePaul)

\$70,000 grant toward technology upgrades and the purchase of medicines.

\$60,000 grant toward upgrade of the elevator at new Madison Road location.

\$50,000 grant toward funding for a new, part-time dentist and dental assistant.

\$45,000 grant toward expansion of the Low Vision Rehabilitation Services program.

Hope House Rescue Mission

\$50,000 grant toward construction of new Center of Hope for Women and Children in Middletown, OH.

Out of the Crossfire (OOTC)

\$45,500 grant toward the addition of two Post-Hospitalization Outreach Worker/Mentor positions.

\$35,000 grant toward recruiting and training more Court-Appointed Special Advocate University (CASA) volunteers.

\$50,000 grant toward installation of an elevator at the Dana Hotel building.

\$50,000 grant toward a new program developed to address the needs of local children with co-occurring diagnoses of developmental disabilities and behavioral health issues.
