- Community and Cultural Vibrancy


From Vision to Action

From Action to Impact

Focused On Community Impact

GCF will play a more active and focused role to drive greater impact on key initiatives. We are making a historic \$150 million investment in the next 10 years to deliver equitable outcomes in three critical areas:

Education

Every child deserves the chance to succeed and meaningful change in student outcomes requires evidence-based solutions. Our approach targets two pivotal moments in a student’s journey: early literacy and future pathways.

GCF will focus on reading proficiency, a key predictor of lifelong success while preparing high school students for post-secondary education, trade school, quality careers, or military service to ensure every child has a path to a bright future.



Housing Affordability

Safe, affordable and stable housing is key to a thriving community. GCF will continue to tackle the urgent need to develop and preserve homes that people can afford.

Nurses, teachers, first responders and working families deserve an opportunity to live where they work –free from rising costs and displacement. By focusing on the production of affordable homes and neighborhood revitalization, we are working to ensure that every resident has a place to call home and a fair shot at building a better future.



Community and Cultural Vibrancy

A dynamic region features healthy people and vibrant places where individuals and families want to stay, grow and invest in their futures. All residents—regardless of zip code— should have access to the physical and mental health resources they need to live full, stable, and healthy lives. From safe public places and accessible parks to behavioral health and wellness initiatives, we will invest in the foundations of individual and community well-being.

We also uplift arts, culture, and community-led initiatives that drive inclusion and deepen civic engagement. When people feel seen, heard, and connected, they are more likely to participate, lead, and shape the future of their communities.

Commitment to Accountability

From Impact to Greater Impact

As the region's leading community foundation for over 60 years, GCF has a long track record of mobilizing financial, social and intellectual capital to accomplish big projects that advance our region in partnership with the community.



Creating Affordable Housing

GCF convened dozens of leaders to commission a report called *Housing Our Future* to identify and address the region's housing needs.


We developed the Affordable Housing Impact Investment Pool in partnership with Cincinnati Development Fund (CDF), seeding it with a \$1 million investment and **raising over \$14 million** as of 2024. These investments have produced over **2,600** affordable rental units and homes.

This partnership created the momentum for CDF to create the Affordable Housing Leverage Fund, unlocking federal funding and **raising over \$112 million** exclusively dedicated to affordable housing.

Preparing Children for Future Success

GCF has made significant investment in education to provide high quality access to educational resources. We supported the launch of Cincinnati Preschool Promise to expand access to high quality preschools that best fit families' and their children's needs.

In the past three years, GCF and its donors have **granted more than \$750,000** to three trusted nonprofit organizations – Preschool Promise, 4C for Children and Learning Grove – working to elevate the early childcare and education landscape in our region.



Advancing Cultural Vibrancy

GCF, along with The Carol Ann and Ralph V. Haile, Jr./U.S. Bank Foundation, co-convened the Cultural Facilities Task Force to save the region's icons. This initiative produced a comprehensive renovation and funding plan for Music Hall and Union Terminal.

Since 2014, GCF and its donors invested in Music Hall a total of over **\$11 million in grants** and **directed \$4.4 million** to Cincinnati Museum Center, keeping our region a world-class destination for arts and culture.
